ANNUAL TOWN MEETING  
TUESDAY, APRIL 14, 2015

The regular scheduled annual town meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Clerk Hoffman at the Town Hall, 1367 Wood Street, Crete, Illinois.

Pledge of Allegiance was given to the flag.

Clerk Hoffman then asked all in attendance for a nomination of a Moderator for the meeting. A nomination was heard by Mr. Michael Liccar and Mr. Anthony Recupito for Mrs. Charlotte Koelling. After three (3) requests, and hearing no other nominations, Mrs. Koelling will moderate the meeting. Oath was given.

Next item on the agenda was to set the moderator's fee. A motion was made by Mr. Frank Elton to set the fee at \$25.00. This motion was seconded by Mr. James Piacentini. By a voice vote the motion was approved, setting the moderator's fee at \$25.00. Moderator Charlotte Koelling expressed an intention to donate the moderator's fee of \$25.00 to the Crete Pantry.

Mrs. Koelling then asked for approval of the minutes of the Annual Town Meeting of April 8, 2014. Motion to approve was made by Mr. Liccar, seconded by Mr. Elton. A voice vote was taken. All were in favor; minutes stand approved as written. Moderator Koelling signed the approved minutes.

The next date for the Annual Town Meeting was set as Tuesday, April 12, 2016. Motion was made by Mr. Richard Most to set the time at 7:00 p.m. and seconded by Mr. Bob Hodge. A voice vote was taken. All were in favor. Motion carried.


RECOMMENDATIONS, RESOLUTION, AND DISCUSSION BY ELECTORS:

Mr. Liccar, a Crete Township Trustee, additionally stated that the actual levy amount is determined by Will County.


