CRETE TOWNSHIP ANNUAL TOWN HALL MEETING

Tuesday April 8, 2025

The Crete Township Annual Town Hall Meeting was called to order by Clerk Buitter at 7:00 PM and it was held at the Crete Township Community Center located at 25930 S. Cottage Grove Avenue, Crete, IL 60417.

A Pledge of Allegiance was given to the flag.

Trustee Liccar made a motion to elect Tim Miller as moderator, seconded by a resident in the crowd. All presents were in favor. Motion passes.

Supervisor Liccar made a motion to set the moderator fee of \$50.00, seconded by a resident in the crowd. All were in favor. Motion passes.

Tim Miller volunteered to donate the \$50 Fee to the Crete Food Pantry.

A motion was made to approve the minutes of April 2024 Annual meeting by a resident and seconded by another resident. All were in favor. Motion passes.

Tim Miller then called up Supervisor Liccar to update us about the new community campus for Crete Township. He discussed how things have changed economically and financially. We received \$822,000 in grant money from Will County, and we have saved up a lot of money from our tax levy, so we purchased this building debt free. He mentioned many items and programs that we hope to have available for the township residents. Several residents asked about having dinners and gatherings and what other activities were being planned. He mentioned that there will be exercise and walking activities. Also, we will have senior lunches and is working on getting a community kitchen so we can have more banquets and lunches and have cooking classes. General discussions ensued about the new building and what opportunities lie ahead for the community. Many citizens were very excited about the community center and looking forward to the activities that will be available to come.


Next on the agenda was the resolution opposing the proposed legislation to consolidate Townships into county government. There was a vibrant discussion about this piece of legislation. Many citizens were very concerned about this legislation. They did not want the township form of government to disappear, especially giving the services to the county or state of Illinois. Most of the people were concerned that the service would be very reduced and substandard. They also viewed that merging the township into the county government would not help save money and might even cause taxes to go up. A resolution

was passed to oppose proposed legislation to consolidate townships into the county government by a clear majority.

A motion was made that next year's annual town meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 14th, 2026, at 7:00PM by Supervisor Liccar, seconded a resident. All were in favor. Motion passes.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Trustee Elton and seconded by Trustee Albrecht. All present in favor and the meeting was adjourned at 7:25 PM
